## SCC RECOMMENDATION



"To seek to establish ... Community Library Partnerships in (14 other communities and) Wiveliscombe"

OR

"Where it does not prove possible to establish Community Library Partnerships, library buildings in those communities would **close**" "Library services (will then be provided) through various combinations of .... **Mobile Library Services** and Digital Library Services"

# WHAT IS A COMMUNITY LIBRARY PARTNERSHIP?



- An alternative to closure
- Partnership between SCC and community partner(s)
- Operates as a normal library part of statutory Library Service
- Libraries West lending stock; computer access, printing and scanning; public wi-fi access; Summer Reading Challenge & Bookstart
- Standards monitored by SCC through a legal contract
- Community managed volunteer run <u>OR</u> community funded SCC run <u>OR</u> hybrid





Core offer – SCC provide at no charge to all CLPs:

- Book stock and refreshment.
- ICT and systems.
- Training, guidance, and technical and professional support.

#### Funding offer for Wiveliscombe CLP:

- £6,000 for running costs per year.
- £1,500 to match staff funding per year.
- Initial 5-year agreement.

CLPs operate Somerset Library policies, procedures and systems.

# OPTION 1 - COMMUNITY MANAGED



- Legal structure e.g. charity
- Trustees / Directors
- Policies
- Recruit and manage volunteers
- Employ staff?
- Property management
- Financial management inc. fundraising
- SCC compliance and liaison

# OPTION 2 – TOWN COUNCIL



#### Wiveliscombe Town Council agree CLP and:

- Pay SCC to staff and manage library.
- Leases/provides building and pay costs, possibly via charity partner if ensures full savings.

#### **Funding:**

- Town Council parish precept on Council Tax.
- Also precept/contributions from parishes and others.

Expected precept per household £5 to £8 per annum (Band D). Maybe smaller precept from parishes willing to contribute.

Friends and other library groups can continue as currently.
